Dr Barry D Weiss is a tenured professor in the Department of Family and Community Medicine at the University of Arizona College of Medicine, and an affiliate professor of public health at the University of Alaska, Anchorage. He is a past chairman of the Department of Family and Community Medicine at the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio.

Dr Weiss has been editor of *Family Medicine*, national journal of the Society of Teachers of Family Medicine, since 1992. He is also editor of the monthly *FP Essentials* monographs, one of the American Academy of Family Physicians' largest continuing medical education programs. In the past he was deputy editor of Micromedex's *Best Practice of Medicine* and series editor of McGraw-Hill's *20 Common Problems* textbook series.

Dr Weiss is the author of more than 135 journal articles, two medical textbooks, several book chapters, and a variety of audio and web-based educational media. He has been a consultant to the Institute of Medicine and served on national committees for the National Institutes of Health, the National Cancer Institute, the American Academy of Family Physicians, the American Medical Association, the American College of Physicians, and numerous corporations and health care systems.

Dr Weiss is board certified in family medicine and holds a certificate of added qualification in geriatric medicine.
